**ST EUGENE SCHOOL—SATs RESULTS**

This year there have been brand new SATs tests with much harder papers and a much more challenging curriculum. Under this new curriculum and testing regime the overall numbers of pupils achieving the expect standard is **53%** nationally. This is significantly lower than in previous years. We are pleased to report that the overall results at **67%** for St Eugene's are significantly above both the National and Camden averages. This is a testament to our dedicated staff and leadership in pushing hard to get the best outcomes for all of our pupils and to the hard work of those pupils.
