Scripture Reflection

The readings invite us to reflect on prayer. In the book of Genesis there is a clear relationship between Abraham and God, expressed both implicitly and explicitly. Abraham intercedes with God on behalf of Sodom, a city full of evil. Troubled by the idea of the innocent being punished along with the guilty, he begins to bargain with God. Even though there is no resolution, the implication is that if there was even one just person in the city, God would spare him.

The Gospel is about persevering in prayer. The important religious truth behind the parable is clearly laid out in Jesus' explanation. 'If you then, who are evil, know how to give your children what is good, how much more will the Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask of Him? As all the spiritual writers have emphasized, prayer is an essential part of discipleship. It is about living in trust in God.

This Wednesday, 27th July at 7.30pm **Fr. Frank Santucci OMI** will lead a talk on **"Do I have a Spirituality for the 21st Century?"** in the Community Centre. Information slips are available at the back of the Church. All are welcome.

World Youth Day takes place this week 25th - 31st July in Krakow, Poland. There will be over 2 million in attendance, along with Pope Francis and Fr. Lylie. Over 20 young people from the UK and Ireland have gone with Fr. Lylie and will meet other young people from Oblate missions throughout the world. Please keep them all in your prayers for a safe journey home and back.
