The Icon

(Reflection by Pope Francis)

“From the event of the Transfiguration I would like to take two significant elements that can be summed up in two words: ascend and descend. We all need to go apart, to ascent the mountain in a space of silence, to find ourselves and better perceive the voice of the Lord. This we do in prayer. But we cannot stay there!

Encounter with God in prayer inspires us anew to ‘descend the mountain’ and return to the plain where we meet many brothers and sisters weighed down by fatigue, sickness, injustice, ignorance, poverty both material and spiritual. To these brothers and sisters in difficulty, we are called to bear the fruit of that experience with God, by sharing the grace we have received”
