A remarkable new film about the inspirational **Catholic philosopher Jean Vanier and the L'Arche communities** he founded was released in cinemas around the UK on the 23 June. The film tells the story of the search for love and friendship by the intellectually disabled members of the the L'Arche communities in France and Bethlehem. It is comic, touching and moving. As one critic said, "it is extremely rare for a film to have the power to change lives. This one really might". Cardinal Cormac Murphy O'Connor has deemed it "a marvelous film that will touch many people" and the Rector of Walsingham Mgr John Armitage describes it as "truly inspirational" Due to overwhelming demand, its cinematic run has been extended through July.
