Pope Francis' Door—Complaining is Forbidden

Whingers, whiners and moaners have been put on notice by Pope Francis who has stuck a big sign to the front door of his Vatican apartment that reads “Complaining is Forbidden”
The sign says that “offenders are subject to a syndrome of victimhood that reduces their sense of humour and capacity to solve problems”
The notice concludes “To become the best of yourself, you must focus on you own potential and not on your limits. So stop complaining and act to change your life for the better”

Famous for his direct language, a few months after he was elected, Francis said “Sometimes there are melancholic Christians with faces like pickled peppers, such long faces, rather than being joyful for the beautiful life they have”
